J.T. CURTIS

John T. Curtis, Jr. (J.T.) is the current Headmaster, Athletic Director and Head Football Coach of John Curtis Christian High School (JCCS). JCCS is a co-ed, non-sectarian, private school in River Ridge, Louisiana. Coach Curtis began teaching and coaching at JCCS in 1969.

Coach Curtis spent three years at the University of Arkansas, where he signed a full athletic scholarship. While working at JCCS, he continued his education where he received his bachelor's degree from Loyola University. He would also receive his master's degree from Loyola in Administration some years later. In 44 years as high school football coach he ranks 2nd all-time in wins with a career record of 520-54-6.

The undefeated 2012 John Curtis football team was the consensus national champion, finishing #1 in five of the seven most widely regarded high school football polls. That team won the 25th state championship in just 44 years under Coach J. T. Curtis; no other high school coach has ever won more than 20. Coach J.T. Curtis was named 2012 Coach of the Year by USA Today. The 2013 team followed by winning the school's 26th state title, reaching the championship game for the 18th straight year, winning 14 times during that stretch including back-to-back-to back titles in 2011-12-13.

On October 27, 2011, Curtis, Jr. became the second football coach—college, prep or pro—to win 500 games.
