Adrienne C. Slack is Vice President and Regional Executive of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta ("Atlanta Fed"), New Orleans Branch.

As part of her role, Adrienne is responsible for the New Orleans Branch Board of Directors, regional Energy Advisory Council, and for providing insight and counsel to the Atlanta Fed's monetary policy process.
